ACM SIGBED/SIGSOFT Frank Anger Memorial Award



An outstanding scientist and national leader in the field of software engineering, Dr. Frank Anger worked to support the crossover of ideas between research communities engaged in software until his untimely death on July 8, 2004. In the spirit of his work and his legacy, the Executive Committees of the ACM Special Interest Groups of Embedded Systems (SIGBED) and of Software Engineering (SIGSOFT), with support from the US National Science Foundation, have established a student travel award in his name. The award provides stipends for two students, one named by each SIG, to attend the flagship conference of the other SIG. The award is meant to improve the mutual awareness of the two research communities to the opportunities and challenges in complimentary research areas.

A student member of SIGSOFT will be provided a stipend of up to \$2000 to cover travel expenses to attend a flagship conference of SIGBED.
